## Read and discuss | Thessalonians 4:11-12 (NTE)

<sup>11</sup> You should make it your ambition to live peacefully, to mind your own business, and to work with your own hands, just as we commanded you, <sup>12</sup> so that you may behave in a way which outsiders will respect, and so that none of you may be in financial difficulties.

\*What is this passage saying to you? \*What does it seem to say about how we work?

#### Our ambition should be to live peacefully

This is a life that is not out to agitate.

\*What would this look like in your life? In your work?

#### Our ambition should be to mind our own business

We each have affairs to mind.

\*What would this look like in your life? In your work? \*What affairs have you been called to mind?

#### Our ambition should be to work with our own hands

Today we are to be a people who work to provide for our needs and the needs of others.

\*How does this ambition apply to the everyday work you do?

#### Our work IS our worship

We can find fulfillment, provision, character building and opportunity in work as worship.

\*How does it compartmentalize our faith to separate work from worship? \*Are there ways that you have seen God's work in your vocation? \*How does it change our perception of our work when it IS work for God?
