**Read and discuss Hebrews 10:23-25 (NTE)**

<sup>23</sup> Let us hold on tightly to our confession of hope, without being diverted; the one who announced the message to us is trustworthy! <sup>24</sup> Let us, as well, stir up one another's minds to energetic effort in love and good works. <sup>25</sup> We mustn't do what some people have got into the habit of doing, neglecting to meet together. Instead, we must encourage one another, and all the more as you can see the great day coming closer.

\*What is this passage saying to you?

\*What does it tell us about living in community with those in the church?

**Neglecting community can become a habit**

When we don't engage in community we begin ejecting from community.

**The gospel calls us to stay in community, even when we disagree**

When people commit to community amidst differences, it deepens faith.

\*With whom are you confessing hope, spurring to love and good works, and encouraging towards the great day?
