Everyone has heard some version of the Gospel

It is not a story about how much you owe God. It is a story about how much you can trust God.

The risen Jesus asks us two things:

Why are you crying?

*Why is your heart troubled? What brokenness and loss are you facing?

Who are you looking for?

*How do things shift when you are looking for a who instead of a what?

*What is so challenging about focusing on the who?

We are saved by the Gospel, and we live by the Gospel

We need it every day.
