## Spiritual disaster can be reshaped into spiritual opportunity

Read and discuss Amos 9:11-15(NIV) " "In that day "I will restore David's fallen and the planter by the one treading grapes. shelter----New wine will drip from the mountains and flow from all the hills, I will repair its broken walls <sup>14</sup> and I will bring my people Israel back from and restore its ruinsand will rebuild it as it used to be, exile. <sup>12</sup> so that they may possess the remnant of "They will rebuild the ruined cities and live in Edom them. and all the nations that bear my name," They will plant vineyards and drink their wine; declares the LORD, who will do these things. they will make gardens and eat their fruit. <sup>15</sup> I will plant Israel in their own land, <sup>13</sup> "The days are coming," declares the LORD, never again to be uprooted from the land I have given them," "when the reaper will be overtaken by the plowman says the LORD your God.

\*What do you see in the contrast of destruction (Chapter 8) and restoration? \*How can a true understanding of God's character help us in the shaking and sifting?
