Reflection & Discussion Questions

The mediocre and amateur performance of the Kingdom song by Christians have convinced some that the song isn't beautiful, and the composer is no good

The most significant way we've gotten the song wrong has been the way we've treated people.

*Why are relational values so important to our participation in the Kingdom?

Everyone is welcome at Pulpit Rock

Every human totally falls short of God's standard, and yet, everyone is created in the image of God and worthy of love. Read and discuss Matthew 5:43-48(NIV)

⁴³ "You have heard that it was said, 'Love your neighbor and hate your enemy.' ⁴⁴ But I tell you, love your enemies and pray for those who persecute you, ⁴⁵ that you may be children of your Father in heaven. He causes his sun to rise on the evil and the good, and sends rain on the righteous and the unrighteous. ⁴⁶ If you love those who love you, what reward will you get? Are not even the tax collectors doing that? ⁴⁷ And if you greet only your own people, what are you doing more than others? Do not even pagans do that? ⁴⁸ Be perfect, therefore, as your heavenly Father is perfect.

- *What do these verses say His love? How we should love?
- *What does it mean to withhold welcome based on sin?
- *How have you seen someone experience Jesus in the ways you or someone else was welcoming?
- *What is beautiful about welcoming the way Jesus did? What is challenging?

I will pour out my Spirit in those days,
