#### Scripture's primary purpose is to point us to Jesus

If we miss this, we can bring some wrong expectations and surface questions to the text.

- \*What are some of the beliefs you've held about what the Bible is for?
- \*How would some of those other purposes inform how we read it and the questions we bring to it?

### The Bible reveals and exposes brokenness in us

Read and discuss Hebrews 4:12-13 (NIV)

<sup>12</sup> For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart. <sup>13</sup> Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account.

- \*What does this passage tell us about how we read the Bible and its purpose?
- \*What are some helpful questions to ask of Scripture when it comes to our brokenness?

# The word of God is only alive and active when it's connected to the Word made flesh...Jesus

Read and discuss Hebrews 4:14-16

<sup>14</sup> Therefore, since we have a great high priest who has ascended into heaven, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold firmly to the faith we profess. <sup>15</sup> For we do not have a high priest who is unable to empathize with our weaknesses, but we have one who has been tempted in every way, just as we are—yet he did not sin. <sup>16</sup> Let us then approach God's throne of grace with confidence, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help us in our time of need.

- \*What do these verses tell us about how we read the Bible and its purpose?
- \*What strategies and tools can we use to help us find Jesus and his work in texts?
- \*How is it possible to use the Bible apart from Him?

- \*Would you say reading the Bible has drawn you into a deeper relationship with Jesus?

- \*Read Romans 3:21-31 or choose a passage to read together and ask these questions:

What does this reveal to me about the brokenness of my heart and my need for Jesus? How does what I'm reading reveal Jesus and point my heart towards him?
