Discussion and Reflection Guide

Paul tells Timothy to stick to the truth of Jesus

Read and discuss 2 Timothy 1:13-14 (NIV)

¹³ What you heard from me, keep as the pattern of sound teaching, with faith and love in Christ Jesus. ¹⁴ Guard the good deposit that was entrusted to you—guard it with the help of the Holy Spirit who lives in us.

*How do you guard the good deposit?

*Why do we need the Holy Spirit's help in this?

Paul went all in with relationships

Read and discuss 2 Timothy 1:15-18 (NIV)

¹⁵ You know that everyone in the province of Asia has deserted me, including Phygelus and Hermogenes.

¹⁶ May the Lord show mercy to the household of Onesiphorus, because he often refreshed me and was not ashamed of my chains. ¹⁷ On the contrary, when he was in Rome, he searched hard for me until he found me. ¹⁸ May the Lord grant that he will find mercy from the Lord on that day! You know very well in how many ways he helped me in Ephesus.

*What can we understand about the relationships in Paul's ministry from this passage?

*Why is it so important to have a team of people, or community in our lives as believers?

Spiritual refreshment from others helps us feel like we can breathe again Onesiphorus showed Paul he was not alone.

*What does spiritual refreshment look like to you?

*Who has been like a deep breath to you lately?

*Have you experienced encouragement to hold on to what's most important? What was that like?

We need people like that...we need to BE people like that

What really matters is Jesus and people.

*Who is the Holy Spirit nudging you to refresh and encourage? What would that look like this week? *Do you sense the Spirt saying something to you about the way you are 'guarding the good deposit'?
