Names and their meanings can hold a lot of importance.

Read and discuss Matthew 1:21 (NIV)

- ²¹ She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will save his people from their sins."
- *Does your name have a meaning or a special story about why you were named that?
- *What names of God resonate deeply with you and why?

Jesus was a common name and translates to the name Joshua in Hebrew

The Joshua we read about in the Old Testament foreshadows Jesus in several ways.

- *How do you see Jesus foreshadowed in the person of Joshua?
- *What does it mean for you to point people to Jesus in your context?

The father of the prodigal son demonstrates love like Jesus

Read and discuss Luke 15:11-24 (NIV)

- I' Jesus continued: "There was a man who had two sons. ¹² The younger one said to his father, 'Father, give me my share of the estate.' So he divided his property between them. ¹³ "Not long after that, the younger son got together all he had, set off for a distant country and there squandered his wealth in wild living. ¹⁴ After he had spent everything, there was a severe famine in that whole country, and he began to be in need. ¹⁵ So he went and hired himself out to a citizen of that country, who sent him to his fields to feed pigs. ¹⁶ He longed to fill his stomach with the pods that the pigs were eating, but no one gave him anything. ¹⁷ "When he came to his senses, he said, 'How many of my father's hired servants have food to spare, and here I am starving to death! ¹⁸ I will set out and go back to my father and say to him: Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. ¹⁹ I am no longer worthy to be called your son; make me like one of your hired servants.' ²⁰ So he got up and went to his father. "But while he was still a long way off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion for him; he ran to his son, threw his arms around him and kissed him.
- ²¹ "The son said to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. I am no longer worthy to be called your son.'
- ²² "But the father said to his servants, 'Quick! Bring the best robe and put it on him. Put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. ²³ Bring the fattened calf and kill it. Let's have a feast and celebrate. ²⁴ For this son of mine was dead and is alive again; he was lost and is found.' So they began to celebrate.
